Overview

- Periodically, updates to the *DiCentra 4* application are made available free of charge.
- This document gives instructions for installing them.
- Your licence details and any competitions are preserved during updating of the application.
- The *DiCentra 4* **User Guide** and a set of **Tutorials** are installed with the software. They can be accessed from *DiCentra 4*'s Help menu.

System Requirements

- DiCentra 4 has no specific memory or processor requirements.
- However, you should ensure that your machine has a display adaptor that will drive your projector in the format you require e.g. 1400 x 1050 pixels, 1920 x 1080 pixels etc.
- DiCentra 4 will run on a PC with:
 - Windows 10
 - Windows 8/8.1
 - o Windows 7
 - Windows Vista SP1 or later (no support from Microsoft after April 2017)
 - Windows XP SP3 or later (no support from Microsoft).

(However, I encourage you to consider moving to Windows 7 or later if you are still running Windows XP or Vista.)

- It will also run on these versions of Windows on a Mac over *Bootcamp*, *Parallels* or *VMWare*.
- DiCentra 4 uses something called 'The .NET Framework 4 Client Profile' from Microsoft. If it is not already on your machine it can be installed at the same time as DiCentra (see below).
- You will need Adobe Reader to be installed on your machine in order to read the documentation.

Installing DiCentra 4 Updates

Updating from DiCentra 3

DiCentra 3 and DiCentra 4 can co-exist on your machine. I suggest you leave DiCentra 3 installed until you are satisfied that upgrading to DiCentra 4 has been successful. You can then uninstall it manually (see below).

Updating from DiCentra 4

- Installing the latest update will normally uninstall the old version of *DiCentra 4* during installation.
- If there is a problem with uninstalling the old version, you will be informed during installation and you will need to uninstall the old version manually (see below).

Getting DiCentra 4 from the Web

- Two *DiCentra 4* installation packages can be downloaded from:
 - www.wilburimaging.com/dicentra
- Use the Web Package if you are installing on a network-connected machine. (About 26 MB download.)

- Use the *Standalone/Full Package* if you want to install it on a machine without network connections. The .NET package will also be installed. (About 68 MB download.)
- Updates are posted there from time to time and recent versions of *DiCentra 4* will inform you when you launch *DiCentra 4* if there is a new version available.

Downloading

- 1. Click the *Download* button on the web page next to the package you need.
- 2. Save the .zip file to a convenient place, e.g. the desktop or your *Downloads\DiCentra* folder.
- 3. Right-click on the .zip file and select Extract All.
- 4. I suggest that you save the .zip file or the extracted folder in *Downloads\DiCentra*. Don't delete after installation. This can then be useful if there is a bug in the latest version that affects you and you need to revert to an earlier version.

Security

You need Administrator privileges to install or uninstall applications, including *DiCentra 4*, on Windows XP, Vista, Windows 7, 8, 8.1 and 10. Your normal login account will probably have such privileges, but if not, log in to a suitable account before trying to install or uninstall *DiCentra 4*.

Versions of Windows, other than Windows XP, try to prevent you from installing software that might harm your computer by displaying a dialogue containing

Unidentified Program Wants to Access Your Computer

or something similar. When this happens, click on the *Details* button and if you see comforting words like Microsoft, Wilbur Imaging or *DiCentra 4* in the details you can safely click *Allow*

In addition, Windows 8 may display a screen-wide banner saying

Windows has protected your PC

or something similar. When this happens, click on *More info ...* and then click on *Run Anyway*

Installing

- 1. Double-click the Setup.exe file in the folder you extracted and installation will begin.
- 2. If you are installing the *Full Package* you may see screens that indicate .NET 4 is being installed. This is normal for machines which do not already have .NET 4 installed.
 - a. (Automatic) downloading of .NET 4 and installation can take between 10 and 20 minutes depending on your machine and network performance.
 - b. To complete .NET 4 installation you may be asked to restart your computer. Do this
 - c. When the restart completes, the rest of the DiCentra installation process will continue automatically.
- 3. You should then get a dialogue saying "Welcome to the *DiCentra 4* Setup Wizard".
- 4. Read the licence agreement and if you agree, select 'I Agree' and then click *Next*.
- 5. Click *Next* to start the installation and once it has completed click *Close*.

DiCentra 4 is now installed on your machine and you will see a shortcut on your desktop and, for Windows 7 and earlier, in your Start menu.

Manually Uninstalling *DiCentra*

Basically, you need to go to Add or Remove Programs in the Windows Control Panel.
 (Typing in Uninstall to the search box on Windows 8 or 10 can get you there quickly.)

- Then locate *DiCentra 3 or 4* in the list of programs. It can take a few seconds for the list to be fully populated.
- Right-click on it or select it and click on Uninstall.
- Follow any on-screen instructions.

Documentation and Samples

- If you are upgrading from a previously licensed version of *DiCentra 3* or *DiCentra 4* the licence(s) will be carried forward at no extra cost.
- Otherwise, DiCentra 4 will run in trial mode until you buy and install a licence. In trial
 mode you are limited to building and running competitions with at most 3 entrants and
 at most 3 images per entrant. You will not be able to run the projector setup functions
 either. You should be able to use all other features.
- Once you have installed *DiCentra 4*, the Windows Start menu contains a folder called *DiCentra 4* (not Windows 8 or later). In it you will find a link to the **User Guide**,
 Tutorials and Release Notes. You will need Adobe Acrobat Reader to read these files, and if you do not have it already there is a link on the *DiCentra 4* download page in order to obtain it.
- These can also be accessed from DiCentra's Help menu. Use:
 - Help > DiCentra User Guide
 - Help > DiCentra Tutorials
 - Help > Release Notes
- When you first start DiCentra 4 it installs sample rules for:
 - a club competition
 - · an inter-club competition, and
 - open competitions with and without club names.
 - portfolio competitions
- A folder called 'DiCentra' is also installed in your 'My Pictures' folder and you will find six folders inside. These are sample images as follows:
 - Folders CD 1 and CD 2 are for the club competition
 - Folders CD 3 and CD 4 are for the inter-club competition
 - Folders CD 5 and CD 6 are for the open competition (with club)
 - Folder CD 7 contains samples for the portfolio competition, and
 - Folder CD 8 contains examples of surname-first entries.
- Hopefully, you will find these useful in familiarising yourself with the rules, assembling and running a competition.
